No one will be discouraged or prevented from making their views known. However, it is important that remarks be restricted to matters contained in the proposed Bylaw.

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Members of Council may, ask questions following presentations however, the function of Council at a Public Hearing is to listen rather than to debate the merits of the proposed Bylaw.

As stated in the Notice of Public Hearing, in general terms, the purpose of the proposed Bylaw is to rezone the subject lands from RR1 (Rural Resource One) to CSF1 (Community Service Facility One), a new site-specific zone to accommodate a recycling facility and other community service uses.
