Pay Parking File No. 4530, 4716 That Council amend the Council Remuneration Policy A-30 by including a section 2.3 that reduces the Mayor's salary by \$10,000, effective immediately.

That Council appoint an Illegal Spaces Task Force Select Committee, comprised of four members of the Canadian Home builders Association, three members of staff and Councillor Duane Jackson to consider the illegal space issue in single family homes only and report to Council with proposed amendments to the bylaws by March 1, 2012; and further,

That Staff be directed to bring back a formal Terms of Reference for this select committee for the December 20, 2011 regular meeting of Council.

That Staff be directed to renegotiate the terms of the Day Lot Operating Agreement with Whistler-Blackcomb with a specific direction to:

- Return Lots 4 and 5 to operation without a user charge.
- b) Continue charging \$8 per day in Lots 2 and 3.
- Set pricing in Lot 1 to \$15 year 'round.
- All Lots be free after 5:00 p.m.

With desired implementation before December 21, 2011.

That the Operating Committee be asked to return to Council with its views respecting the allocation of day lot revenue.

That staff investigate the feasibility of providing pro-rated refunds for all purchasers of day lot or RMOW pass products and report to Council respecting this on December 20, 2011.

And That should the Operating Committee agree to rate changes, staff be instructed to prepare the 2012 Municipal Budget based on \$\$645,000 in day lot Special Council Meeting Agenda December 7, 2011 Page 2

revenue rather than \$988,000 that was anticipated as a result of rates that were implemented on November 1, 2011.
