**That** Council of the Resort Municipality of Whistler (RMOW) in open meeting assembled, hereby resolves that the RMOW, as a shareholder of Whistler.com Systems Inc. pass the Consent Resolutions attached as Appendices A, B and C to Administrative Report No. 24-017, and that the consent resolutions be executed by the corporate signatories on behalf of the RMOW.

#### **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

The purpose of this report is to seek Council's approval and execution by the corporate signatories of the annual Shareholders' Consent Resolutions of Whistler.com Systems Inc. (Whistler.com)

#### DISCUSSION

#### **Background**

Whistler.com is a reservations, call centre and event booking system. 51 per cent of its shares are owned by the Resort Municipality of Whistler (RMOW) and 49 per cent of its shares are owned by Whistler Resort Association (dba as Tourism Whistler).

The Directors of Whistler.com have approved the Financial Statements and the Directors' Consent Resolutions are attached as Appendix D.

### **Analysis**

#### Change in Directors

The RMOW have been notified that Roger Soane resigned as a director of Whistler.com with effect from May 4, 2023. The Shareholders' Consent Resolutions reflecting that change are attached as Appendix A and require shareholder approval. Tourism Whistler has signed the resolution.

The RMOW have also been notified that Kevin Small has consented to being appointed as a director of Whistler.com with effect from October 24, 2023. The Shareholders' Consent Resolutions approving this appointment are attached as Appendix B and require shareholder approval. Tourism Whistler has signed the resolution.

#### **Annual Filings**

The Shareholders' Consent Resolutions, attached as Appendix C, resolves that:

- > the annual reference date is December 10, 2023, the date of incorporation;
- > the financial statements of Whistler.com for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2023 be accepted;
- > Barrett Fisher, Virginia Cullen and Kevin Small be appointed as the Directors of Whistler.com; and
- the appointment of an auditor for Whistler.com be waived.

#### **POLICY CONSIDERATIONS**

### Relevant Council Authority/Previous Decisions

Section 182 of the *Business Corporations Act*, provides that a company may consent in writing to all of the business required at the annual general meeting.

Section 203 of the *Business Corporations Act*, provides that a company may consent in writing to waive the appointment of an auditor.
