<p>Plywood for Gym Floor: Safety equipment is crucial for all programs run by Whistler Gymnastics. One of the areas of the gym that requires an upgrade is underneath our gymnastics floor. Our spring gymnastics floor sits on top of a thin layer of rubber matts that were installed as part of the original gym space from the 2010 Winter Olympics. Unfortunatley, the cushioning effect of these rubber pads lessens the springing effect of our floor which results in a less than optimal gym floor. By placing a layer of plywood flooring on top of the rubber matts, our spring floors will provide maximum rebound for increased performance and decreased impact mitigating injury and athlete wear and tear. We are requesting \$3,059.64 to cover the cost of the plywood.</p>
