1 - Paying Coaches

We are hoping to increase our membership by maximizing exposure to field hockey amongst the local community. For the youth program, in addition to running our spring and fall youth sessions, we hope to send coaches to run sessions at local elementary schools, Kids on the Go, Whistler Youth Soccer Club, and Whistler Sport Legacies' summer camps. For the adult program, in addition to our winter indoor and summer outdoor sessions, we'd like to host "Try it for Free" events run by a coach and umpire. Ideally, we would like to hire a consistent part-time head coach to co-ordinate coaching for both programs.

2 - Operational & Event Costs

Funding would be used towards paying for insurance and fees for banking, website, and administration. We would also use this funding towards the entrance fees for various tournaments we plan to send teams to this year.

3 - Purchasing Equipment

In order to improve our indoor sessions, we require fold-able sideboards to be used along the sides of the gym. A member has offered to make these if we provide the materials. We require a new goalkeeper's helmet as the goalkeeper's kit owned by the club was purchased second-hand and the helmet no longer meets safety requirements. We also need some new indoor balls and coaching equipment.
