Ms. Stippler represents the Whistler horticulture industry and requested Council to consult with stakeholders regarding the proposed "Outdoor Potable Water Usage Amendment Bylaw (Irrigation Definitions, Stages and Schedules) No. 2428, 2024" (Bylaw). Ms. Stippler felt that consultation was not sufficient.

Ms. Stippler was concerned about the Bylaw's impact on the environment, community and horticulture industry. She noted we need to reduce water waste but cannot sacrifice plants. She proposed smart water usage as opposed to prescribed water use times. The importance should be placed on ensuring plants thrive so they can help with climate change, fire smart, and health benefits.
