Re: Illumination Request of The Fitzsimmons Covered Bridge on October 9th

On behalf of Inflamed Brain Alliance (IBA), I'm inquiring about lighting-up The Fitzsimmons Covered Bridge in the color RED on World PANS/PANDAS Awareness Day this October 9, 2023 to raise awareness of the autoimmune neuropsychiatric condition - PANS/PANDAS.

One of the ways they aim to do so is with national campaigns, such as our **Light-Up For PANS/PANDAS campaign** on World PANS/PANDAS Awareness Day.
