**That** the recommendation of the General Manager of Infrastructure Services be endorsed.

### RECOMMENDATION

**That** Council approve the name “Alta Place” for the private road entering the Prism Properties development from Alta Lake Road as shown on Figure 1 attached as Appendix “A” to Administrative Report No. 20-068.

### PURPOSE OF REPORT

Council has the authority to name roads within Whistler and the Prism Properties development has one private road that requires naming.

### DISCUSSION

When the Prism Properties development was recently authorized, it was addressed accordingly within the 1500 block of Alta Lake Road. Converting the long strata driveway for this development into a private road with its own name will allow emergency responders and others to more easily locate the residences. Additionally, prior to the Prism Properties development, there was no road access to the future resident housing parcel, currently addressed as 1451 Alta Lake Road. The creation of the private road will provide this parcel with unique Alta Place addresses when developed. The proposed name for the one private road in the Prism Properties development is “Alta Place” as shown on Figure 1 attached.

Council routinely assigns street names to new roads as they are built, in accordance with the Road Naming Procedure published in 1992.
