We are writing to request that the decision to go forward with the project for burying the hydro lines in Whitegold be reconsidered for the following reasons:

The group of Whitegold residents who oppose this project request a voice to show the lack of support and the reasons why. There are residents that now have a better understanding of the impact this project has on their neighborhood, they should be allowed to rescind their vote. This should include an independent scrutiner to count the votes to confirm their support.

- COST – there is no firm cost for this project
- HARDSHIP – Whitegold is one of the oldest neighborhoods in Whistler, home to many retirees who are on fixed incomes and cannot pay for this beautification luxury
- LACK OF TRANSPARENCY – There has been no consultation with the Whitegold residents. The group who spearheaded this project excluded anyone from communication when they voiced their opposition to this group
- EXTENSION – The group did not get the required vote in the allocated time and then were granted an extension
- REAL ESTATE ACTIVITY – A number of homes have been sold during the allocated time
