> Subject: Mask mandate advertising

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Dear Mayor and Council,

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> I wanted to raise your awareness and hope you bring this to council too, that your ad campaign for masks is leaving people with the impression that they don't have to respect mask exemptions or the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms. No where on any piece of advertising print or social media does it state anywhere that mask exemptions are being followed. I just had a terrible experience in [REDACTED] today while trying to buy a shovel with [REDACTED] where I was told there is no such thing as mask exemptions. When I told them they were and their were in violation of the charter and our Canadian Human Rights Act, they referenced Whistler's ads where there is no mention of any exemption so they didn't have to give one. I am having [REDACTED] being actively discriminated against because he has a disability and your campaign is indeed adding to this. If you advertise about masks and make no mention of exemptions it is setting the stage for discrimination, and I never thought you were the person to promote this type of behaviour but your ad campaign says otherwise.

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> I am getting very fed up with this and am actively telling people not to come to Whistler because of the discrimination that exists here and the lack of empathy for people with any kind of medical condition or disability, that the business here are not friendly and don't deserve anyone's money.
