Dear Mayor, Council & RMOW CEP Grant Program Coordinating Staff RE: 2020 Community Enrichment Program (CEP) Grant

In the 2020 CEP grant cycle AWARE was awarded \$5,000 to support the implementation of initial early win climate actions identified as part of the Climate Action Campaign Jam, which we were designing as a conference-styled space for community members from throughout the region to mobilize on climate action campaigns.

At the time of CEP application we had the Climate Action Campaign Jam scheduled for May. As with many events the pandemic caused cancellation of the plans for an in-person gathering. As we shift to an online format for the event we identified February 2021 as the best option for new timing recognising that: businesses as one of our main target audiences would likely be stretched through Fall with the predicted (and now underway) second wave of covid; and that a backlog of postponed spring events would make the end of year busy for all of our target audiences. The postponement of the event clearly delays the use of the 2020 CEP funding to allow us to support the implementation of initial early win campaign actions.

The \$5000 of CEP funding remains on hand and ready for use as intended. As per our application - funds will cover time and tools needed to support assigned lead individuals and organisations bringing early win climate actions to fruition. This early-win action support will allow momentum from the event to be maintained, helping to keep people engaged while also bridging any actions where we would need to seek suitable funding for actions that are longer-term or where significant investment is needed. This means funds will now be spent in March & April of 2021 (i.e. for 2 months following the climate action event).

We are and will continue to engage with staff, Council and partners as this project is delivered and look forward to reporting back in full upon completion.
