Pathways Serious Mental Illness Society (Pathways SMIS), is a volunteer-driven, working primarily with family members/caregivers of those who suffer from serious mental illness providing peer support, education, advocacy, programs and services, at no cost to the community.

Family-to-Family Education program: This course is offered as a peer-to-peer educational program, taught by trained family-member volunteers who teach the cohort of students. The teachers offer a lot of understanding and compassion, as they too have a loved one with a serious mental illness. Pathways offers the course twice a year and we are looking to expand this program in 2021, due to an increase in demand in 2020.

In 2020, we adapted the course to be delivered online via Zoom. We saw an increase in demand for our Family-to-Family course; from 47 people who registered for our 'in-person' Fall course in 2019, to 130 people who register their interest for the 'online' Fall course of 2020.

By moving our programs online, we increased accessibility for all service users, and particularly, for the safely of our staff and volunteers, and those most at risk due to Covid-19. This has meant we have recruited volunteers and dedicated more staff time to supporting our service users in a Technical capacity.

Our Awareness and Early Intervention program have an impact on reducing the stigma and discrimination experienced by the mentally ill and promoting their acceptance by the community at large.

Our centre provides support through a number of means: one-to-one support; our Family Navigator helps people find suitable information and services they need; and support group sessions facilitated by family member volunteers who deliver the peer-to-peer sessions. All of our services our being delivered online due to covid-19.

We believe this increased demand was a result of a number of factors, including:

- Moving our programs online have made them more accessible for people/families affected by serious mental illness
- Moving the support groups and course online has allowed us to expand into new communities physical presence is no longer a barrier
- The Family-to-Family course has been condensed to an 8-week course making it more manageable, less of a time commitment and therefore more accessible for people
- Moving the support groups and course online has made it less of a time commitment, and therefore more accessible for people

The fund were spent on helping Pathways SMIS deliver the above programs and towards salaries of staff working on delivering these programs.

# Was This a New Program or Activity?

If yes, please describe if the program was a success or needs improvement, and if it will continue in future years.

No, it was an existing program but we made adaptations to the program to enable us to deliver them online. Moving to delivering our program online has made them more accessible to the community up in Whistler and Sea to Sky. We have seen an increase in the uptake of our programs and services. We would like to continue building on this success, make improvements with the new chnages we have made and work to expand the program given the increase in demand.




