The primary goal of using grants received is to continue to keep cost of participating for families low. We are happy to say we are remain one of the most affordable recreation options, offering roughly 7 months of coached play for under \$500. The bulk of the grant money this year was spent on ensuring we could pay for additional coaches to meet the health requirements for operating. When the Covid 19 pandemic was declared operations were halted until safe return to play guidelines could be developed and then implented. We were able to adapt by, creating a temporary budget, changing programming to meet the required coach to player ratio as well as meet the maxiumum 49 person capacity on the playing field by expanding our field rental times for smaller groups more often on the field. Smaller groups more often with constant attention to Covid - 19 protocols required hiring additional coaching that we were able provide in large part the Community Enrichment Grant. We were also able to provide hand sanitizer and PPE to our players at the field at all times.

When the Covid - 19 Pandemic was declared we created a temporary budget to account for all the changes we needed to make in order to cover costs and continue to provide prorgamming when it was safe to do so again. As a result of diligence and an increase in demand for soccer (being an outdoor sport) when we were able to return to play we were able to reallocate money and provide an outdoor reacreationnal option to our community's youth at the same cost to families while increasing our certified coaching staff to meet the health and safety guidelines required by the Ministry of Health and ViaSport (the agency tasked with return to play guidelines). As a result of the additional funding from the Coomunity Enrichment Program Grant we were able to provide a spot for every child that wanted to play by being able to hire extra coaches.

On behalf of the Coaches, Board of Directors and over 300 youth participants of the Whistler Youth Soccer Club, we would like to thank the RMOW for its CEP grant in the amount of \$5,000.00.

These funds are vital to our organization—In a year like no other we were able to provide a safe, outdoor recreational option for any youth that wanted to play. We were able to hire additional certified coaches who were able to maintain return to play guidelines put in place to keep every player safe, healthy and on the field.

Our 2020 grant application funding request was used for:

1/ Technical Director and part time coaching staff wages3/ Hand Sanitizer, Masks and disposable gloves

When the Covid 19 pandemic was declared, soccer operations were suspended until the summer when we were able to offer programming that was individual skills and drills only, which progressed into limited contact practices and then onto games that were adapted to remove the most risky of behaviour (throw ins and heading).

To meet the required coach to registrant ratio as well as to ensure we had qualified coaches able to manage the continuous monitoring and management of players, social distancing, hand sanitizing and equipment management we hired an additional paid coach to be on the field at all times.

With some creative programming, a clear return to play plan and strong capable coaching we were able to operate and provide the community with a safe and affordable outdoor activity.

We felt strongly that kids need a safe opportunity to move and be involved with peers while meeting all health guidelines and requirements.
