\$6,000 to provide much needed bursaries to low income Whistler Residents ages 3 and up to access our sport, therapeutic and recreational programs. Individuals are eligible to apply for up to \$1,000 per year across our four season programming. The bursary covers approximately 30% of the annual Sport Academy fees for our regular Sport Academy athletes and the athletes pay to remaining 70% of their sport fees out of their own discretionary income. Bursary recipients must pass a financial means test and are vetted by a three person Bursary Committee.

Whistler Adaptive anticipates receiving bursary applications from up to 24 low income Whistler Residents going into winter programming from individuals physical, sensory and cognitive disabilities. The bursaries, funded through the CEP grant, will allow them to participate in the following COVID-19 safety formatted programming: Nordic skiing and snowshoe, yoga, physical literacy programming and club formatted alpine skiing and snowboarding.

We plan on delivering 7 days a week of programming this winter, children and youth with a special emphasis on Whistler locals. Due to COVID-19 safety protocols, we are unable to do any group based activities. All of our programming is currently "bubble" formated or private. The bursaries are helping keep up our capacity for Whistler residents to participate in adaptive sports and recreation programming by keeping their sport and recreation costs at a reasonable rate.

We are in the process of starting the distribution of the \$6,000 received in bursaries for 2020; as the funding was only awarded in August and the bulk of our fall and winter programming is only now just resuming due to the latest Provincial Health Order. We will allow the bursaries to be applied to outstanding invoicing from September to November 2020 as a one-time exception due to COVID-19.

We have received 12 Whistler Resident applications to date. We will report back with our 2021 budget and an updated report on bursary usage by mid-January.

We will need to also reduce the bursary amount awarded to each individual this year in order to ensure that everyone requiring a bursary receives one.
