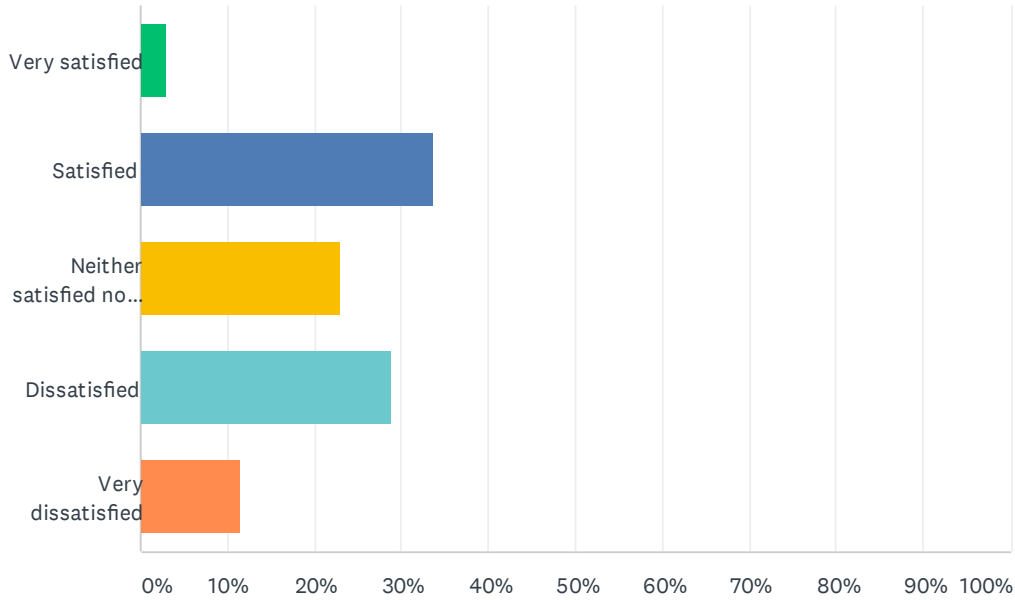


Q1 After viewing the presentation, how satisfied are you with the outlined priorities and spending in the Resort Municipality of Whistler's 2021 Budget?

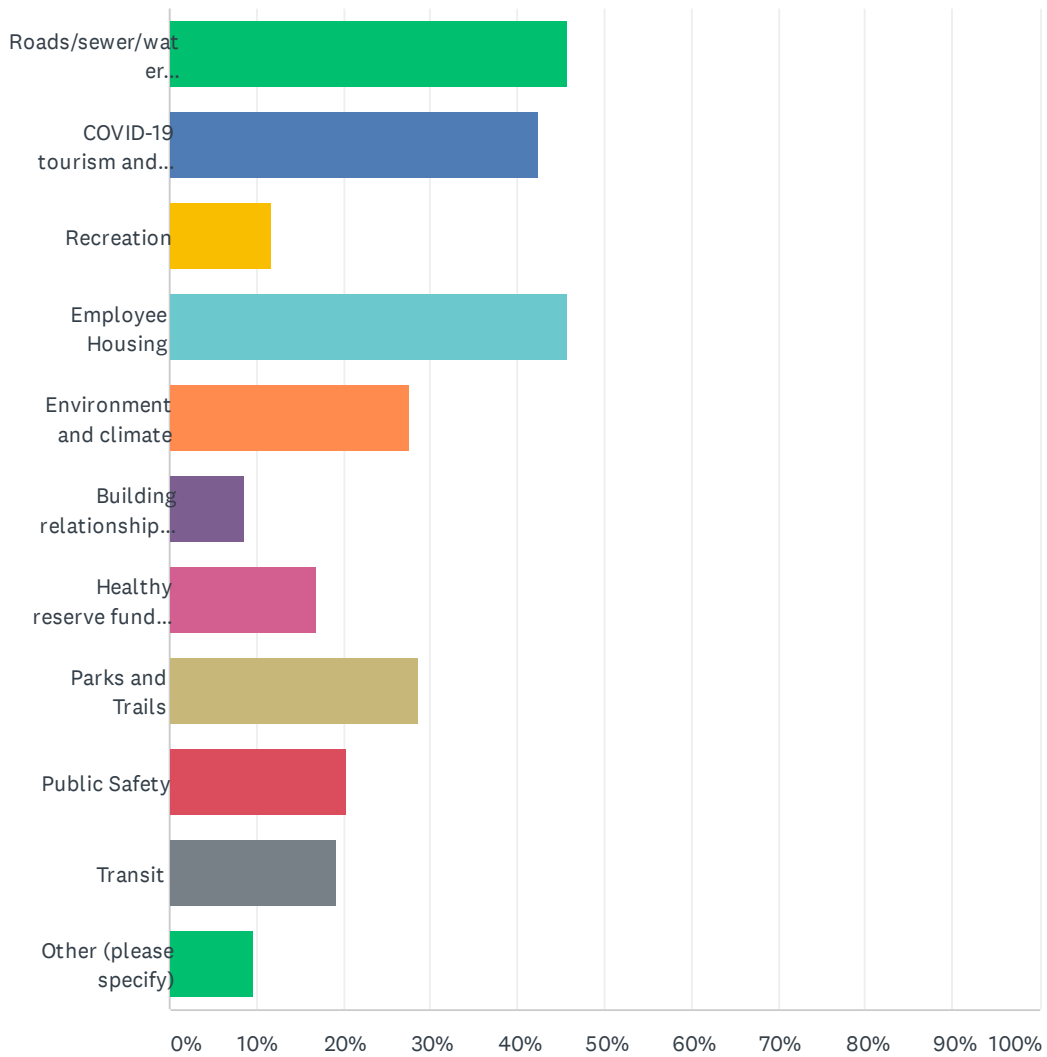

Q4 If you were to choose something to leave out of the 2021 Budget, what would that be?

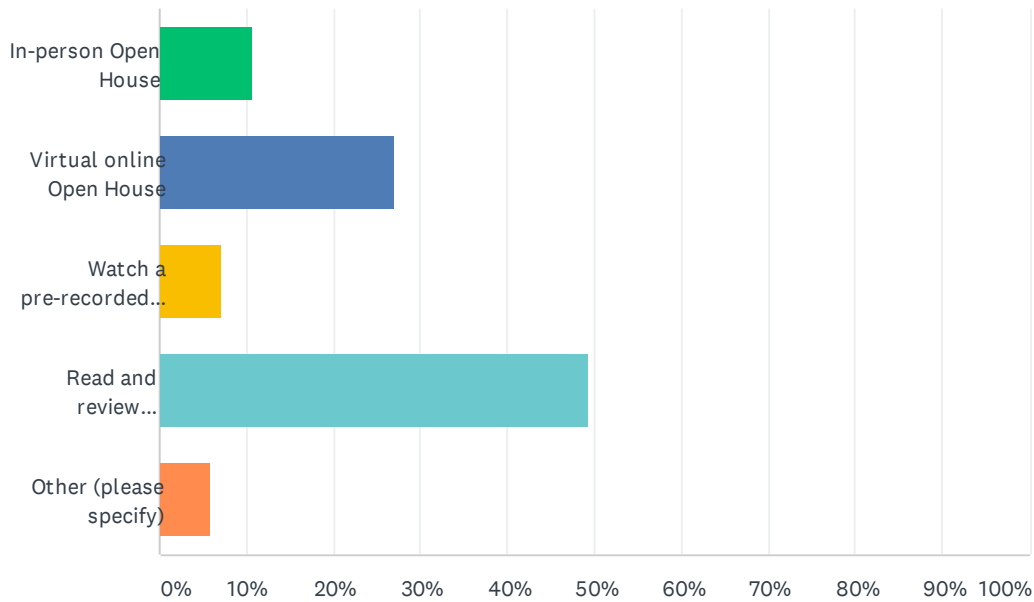
