Grant Request: \$6,000

- 1) We would like to use \$2,000 for repairing our existing roller skis to give them a longer life and for purchasing new Classic technique roller ski equipment that can be used to support our expanded summer and fall programs.
- 2) We would like to use the remaining \$4,000 for coaching expenses. Our coaching expense is by far our largest expense. The grant would help us expand our programming into the summer and fall as well as help provide additional coaching for the increase in athletes to all our winter programs. We strive to keep the costs to families as low as possible, however biathlon is a coach intensive sport that has additional coaching responsibilities which means our coaching costs are higher than for some other sports.

2. Is This a New Program or Activity?

If yes, what are your targets and goals for this program/activity?

While our core programming has not changed (Biathlon, XC Skiing and Ski Jumping) we continue to expand our programs as demand has increased. We have introduced all girls programming for both Biathlon and XC Skiing which has been very successful. In addition, our Summer and Fall programming has expanded to meet our athletes needs. We also now offer a full Masters program in both Biathlon and XC to meet the demand for that programming.

3. Current Year Highlights and Community Benefits:

With almost 400 registered participants, this will be the biggest intake ever for our club. Our Biathlon program is one of the largest in the country, which is a testament to the legacy of the 2010 Olympic games. While there were no official competitions this year, we currently have over 20 biathletes who have been selected to various BC Provincial Squads for the 2020-2021 season. Our program offerings have become an integral part of winter sports programming for Whistler families and given the need for families to play outside this year, we have made a significant contribution to family health both physical and mental.




