The WDGC would like to make Whistler a known destination for disc golf. The course has been featured twice on social media by UDISC, a very popular disc golfing app. Last season brought disc golf to the mainstream with ESPN showing 2 seperate events, the Dynamic Disc Open and the PDGA Tour Finnale.

The WDGC encourages people of all ages and abilities to come outside and have a great time playing a safe sport. We take the time to teach anyone that wants to get better at the sport. The club hosts an all abilities doubles night (each week once the snow melts) at no cost. We host other informal events on the course and training sessions at Spruce Grove Park. The course itself provides the community with a rare affordable entertainment alternative. The club is continually maintaining the course as the sport of disc golf is one of the fastest growing sports in the world and the standards of courses are continuing to change year to year. We would like to host 3 tournaments in the 2021 season, 2 for locals and 1 regional. If we can get baskets into the local school fields we would like to partner with teachers and students to introduce them to the sport, leading to a local junior only toumament being added to our schedule, and the longer term goal of hosting a large regional/Canadian National junior toumament on an annual basis.
