Covid19 has negatively impacted the Whistler Singers. Revenues are down significantly and yet costs to maintain the choir remain fixed. Membership dues and concert donations are important sources of revenue, yet due to covid we were unable to hold both the spring and Christmas concerts. We provided pre-recorded songs for the municipality to use for the virtual Remembrance Day ceremony 2020. For the holiday season, the Whistler Singers partnered with the Whistler Childrens' Chorus to videotape songs and readings for the 30th annual Christmas Eve Carol Concert. The video was made available to local hotels for screening, and it was also posted on the Whistler Singers Facebook page. Since the fall of 2020 the choir has met virtually via Zoom to practice. Whistler Singers is trying to remain viable during this challenging time, and receiving a CEP grant will allow the choir to continue. We anticipate a rise in membership when covid19 restrictions are lifted. Our members enjoy singing together and look forward to once again being a vital part of the arts community in Whistler.
