Pre-covid we were receiving up to \$5000 in labour and materials from the parks department to upgrade teepads and remove safety hazards (trees) from the course.

<p>The purpose of the grant is to replace the aging baskets some of which are 20 years old and improve playability on the course. New baskets are approx. \$270USD each, with shipping expected to be \$70-100/basket, this puts the cost of new baskets at approx. \$12,000 CAD. The club has over \$9000 in cash from fundraising efforts. If the grant is approved, and we are given permission, we would like to approach local sea to sky schools to see if they would be interested in installing 1 or more of the old baskets in their fields.</p> <p>Getting kids involved in playing is a great way to grow the sport and also provide local families with an affordable pastime they didn't know they could do together. 18 of the old baskets could be used to test the layout of the new course proposed by the RMOW.</p> <p>Getting our equipment up to current standards will help us host more quality tournaments. We currently have the Sea To Sky Open, which provides the third largest tournament payout in BC. This year (if covid allows) we expect to draw 80 players and their families to Whistler for the 2 day event.</p> <p>The WDGC would like to make Whistler a known destination for disc golf. The course has been featured twice on social media by UDISC, a very popular disc golfing app. Last season brought disc golf to the mainstream with ESPN showing 2 separate events, the Dynamic Disc Open and the PDGA Tour Finale.</p>

<p>The WDGC encourages people of all ages and abilities to come outside and have a great time playing a safe sport. We take the time to teach anyone that wants to get better at the sport. The club hosts an all abilities doubles night (each week once the snow melts) at no cost. We host other informal events on the course and training sessions at Spruce Grove Park. The course itself provides the community with a rare affordable entertainment alternative. The club is continually maintaining the course as the sport of disc golf is one of the fastest growing sports in the world and the standards of courses are continuing to change year to year. We would like to host 3 tournaments in the 2021 season, 2 for locals and 1 regional. If we can get baskets into the local school fields we would like to partner with teachers and students to introduce them to the sport, leading to a local junior only tournament being added to our schedule, and the longer term goal of hosting a large regional/Canadian National junior tournament on an annual basis.</p>

Disc golf is played by hundreds if not thousands of locals, having new equipment will show the Municipalities commitment to providing a low cost, top level activity. The new baskets will be much more visible making it easier for new players to join and enjoy the sport, as it can be difficult to see the current baskets when you are first starting out. Life in Whistler can be tough, having a regular affordable (almost free) pastime shared with friends helps the local community feel a sense of belonging. - This grant would help the WDGC address the priority or enhancing the resort experience by increasing visitor satisfaction and Whistler atmosphere. Disc golf is one of the fastest growing pastimes in the world, having updated baskets increases the satisfaction and the atmosphere of visitors that have previously played disc golf and understand that our current equipment is dated. It helps the flow of players by easily being able to identify the next target. Whistler is a world renowned outdoor destination and the expectation is that our equipment would be up to the current standards. - This grant is the next step in helping the WDGC ensuring economic viability as it give us the opportunity to run the highest level tournament, the course needs more upgrades and features, but this change will help grow its reputation.</p>

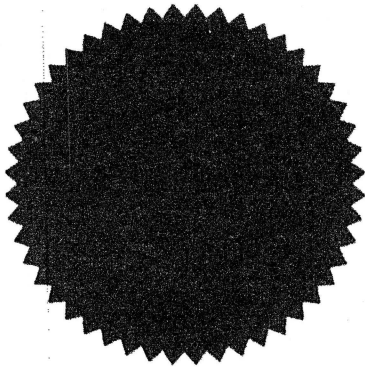
