The purpose of the grant is to facilitate building a batting cage as well as purchase accessories to go with our pitching machine. WSPA caters to players of all ability levels. There are six divisions ranging from A to F. We have many new players every year who have never played slo ptich/ softball/baseball before. We also have a large group of competitive players that could use this for training opportunities. We host a free "women's clinic" early in the season every year for skill development and plan on hosting more clinics. The batting cage would allow us to provide more skill development opportunities for all of our players from beginners to elite. Having a batting cage offers more flexibility to use the pitching machine we purchased last year. We know that many WSPA players would use it regularly and we also hope to allow community members to use it and get introduced to this social sport. We envision families wanting to use it as well.


