I ask you to kindly keep in place a decision that was made to move us to a more peaceful Olympic Legacy neighbourhood. Though not perfect we have appreciated the asphalt plant operating less so that we might enjoy more days with a quality of life expected in a beautiful resort such as ours.

With the addition of 2 and soon to be 3 new housing areas to our neighbourhood plus a soccer field, it is even more important to lessen the impact of heavy industry down here.

I feel the extra cost imposed by the proprietor of Alpine to transport from his Squamish plant is small compared to the 22% decrease in cost once this business after decades went to tender and the huge tax base Cheakamus Crossing contributes. Not sure you can put a price on quality of life ....

This is an amazing neighbourhood and often I imagine it someday as it should be but for now we would appreciate you keeping this decision in place.
