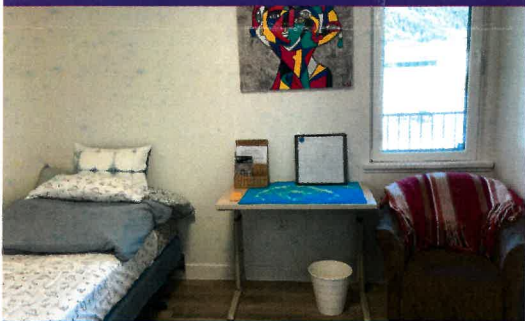




We have hired 3 graduates in the last year. Their experience and skills make this program better.
